**NOTICE ON DEBTOR’S MOTION TO ASSUME EXECUTORY CONTRACT  
WITH MACALLISTER MACHINERY CO., INC.**

The Debtor herein has filed with the Court the Motion to Assume Executory Contract with MacAllister Machinery Co., Inc. (the “Motion”). The Motion requests that the Debtor be authorized to assume the executory contract (the “Contract”) with MacAllister Machinery Co., Inc. (“MacAllister”) for the continued sales of parts and repairs to the extensive inventory of Caterpillar equipment owned and/or leased by the Debtor. In support of the request to assume the Contract, the Debtor indicates that a substantial amount of its equipment has been manufactured by Caterpillar. MacAllister is the local dealer for Caterpillar parts and services, and there are no other such dealers in Indiana. The Debtor believes it is in its best interest to maintain its relationship with MacAllister to insure unencumbered continued supply of parts and services from MacAllister.
