ORDER AND NOTICE OF HEARING ON FIRST DAY MOTIONS

On March 4, 2010, the above captioned Debtor commenced its Chapter 11 bankruptcy case by filing a voluntary petition for relief under Chapter 11 of Title 11 of the United States Code. The Court shall conduct a hearing in Courtroom 325, United States Bankruptcy Court, 46 E. Ohio Street, Indianapolis, Indiana, on the First Day Motions, and any objection thereto, on **March 10, 2010, at 1:30 p.m. EST**. All interested parties are welcome, but are not required, to attend the hearing.

Counsel for the Debtor is ordered to serve copies of the First Day Motions and this notice on all creditors and parties in interest as required by Local Rule B-9013-3(d), and file with this Court before the above hearing a certificate of mailing in respect of such service.
