**NOTICE ON DEBTOR’S MOTION TO REJECT UNEXPIRED  
LEASE WITH MARLIN LEASING**

The Debtor herein has filed with the Court the Motion to Reject Unexpired Lease with Marlin Leasing (the “Motion”). The Motion requests that the Debtor be authorized to reject the unexpired lease (the “Lease”) of a Konica 7222 digital copier and a Sharp 525 facsimile.
